Guidelines & Limitations

- ◆ Must be a Boone County Resident
- ◆ Only Residential Waste Accepted - No Business or Industrial Waste
- ◆ Tire Limits -
4 Vehicle or Truck Tires
2 Tractor Tires
Combination thereof (4 Tire Max.)

Do NOT Bring:

- ◆ Radioactive Waste
- ◆ Explosives
(Ammunition, Fireworks, Flares, Etc.)
- ◆ Alkaline Batteries
(AA/AAA/C/D/9V are Non-Hazardous)
- ◆ Latex Paint
(Latex Paint is Non-Toxic & should be allowed to dry out (Cat Litter helps) until it is non-liquid, then place it in the trash)

Directions:

- ◆ I-65 Exit #130 - IN 334
- ◆ East 4.2 miles on IN 334
- ◆ Town Hall on North side of the road (one-way entrance). Event will be in the rear parking lot of building.

Accepted Items:

- ◆ Antifreeze
- ◆ Brake Fluid
- ◆ Motor Oil
- ◆ Small Propane Tanks
- ◆ Glues & Adhesives
- ◆ Fire Extinguishers
- ◆ Fluorescent Tube Lights/CFL Bulbs
- ◆ Oil Based Paint/Thinner/Stain
- ◆ Pesticides/Herbicides/Insecticides
- ◆ Medical Waste (Prescriptions / Sharps / Over-the-Counter Meds / Pet Meds/etc.)



- ◆ Gasoline
- ◆ Household Cleaners
- ◆ Aerosols
- ◆ Pool Chemicals
- ◆ Thermometers & Thermostats
- ◆ Batteries (Automobile & Rechargeable)



New Collection Items:

- ◆ Tires (See Limits)
- ◆ Electronics (Free, with the exception of a \$10 Donation for Tube based TVs)
