The Lebanon Educational Foundation's standard scholarship application must be completed for all scholarships listed below. **Applications will be made available on the Lebanon Educational Foundation website at www.lebanonlef.org after December 6, 2011.** One application can be used for all LEF scholarships.

The scholarships listed below are the scholarships which are available through the Lebanon Educational Foundation as of December 2011. This list is subject to change. Scholarships may be added or removed from the list based on fund availability and market fluctuations. STUDENTS SHOULD CHECK THE LEF WEBSITE OR CONFIRM SCHOLARSHIP AVAILABILITY WITH THE LHS GUIDANCE DEPARTMENT PRIOR TO COMPLETING THE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION.

Big O Tires Scholarship \$1,500.00

The recipient must be a LHS senior student who has been accepted into a trade school, in-state or out-of-state. The recipient must have a 3.0 GPA or higher. The scholarship is not limited by financial need. The Scholarship Committee of the Lebanon Educational Foundation (LEF) will make the final selection.

Boone County Family YMCA Sam Thayer Memorial Volleyball Scholarship \$100.00

The recipient must be a LHS junior or senior student who will attend a four year college or university. No specific field of study is required to receive this scholarship. The recipient must be a student citizen in good standing; has participated in high school volleyball for two years and have volunteer service in the Lebanon community. The scholarship is not limited by financial need. The team members of the Lebanon High School Volleyball Team will select the recipient.

Boone County Realtors \$500.00

The Boone County Realtors have established a scholarship for a student who has been accepted into a technical or trade school, in-state or out-of-state. The recipient must have maintained a C average or above during all four years of high school. No specific area of study is required and the scholarship is not based on financial need. The Scholarship Committee of the Lebanon Educational Foundation will make the final selection.

Boone REMC Community Fund, Inc., Operation Round Up Scholarship \$1,000 .00

The Boone REMC has established this scholarship using funds from Operation Round Up for a Lebanon High School student pursuing post-secondary training in a vocational/technical school. The recipient must have at least a "C" average or better to apply. The Scholarship Committee of the Lebanon Educational Foundation will make the final selection.

Carol Belles Music Memorial Scholarship \$500.00

The recipient must be a LHS senior student who has participated in a minimum of 3 years of choir and/or band during high school and plans to attend a four year college or university. Selection preference will be given to any applicant(s) who plans to major in performing arts, music, drama or band. The Scholarship Committee of the Lebanon Educational Foundation will make the final selection.

Cheryl Ann Cowan Memorial Scholarship \$500.00

Recipient must be accepted and plan to attend a state-supported university, majoring in Elementary Education and must be in the top 20% of the graduating class. The Scholarship Committee of the Lebanon Educational Foundation will make the final selection.

David Limp Memorial Baseball Memorial Award \$1,000.00

The award will recognize a student who is a senior on the LHS baseball team. This student must have a passion for baseball that he will carry with him through his entire life. The recipient must also have good character and sportsmanship qualities, which is how David Limp was remembered by his peers, family and community. The coach of the LHS Baseball team will select the winner each year.

Denger Family Scholarship \$8,000.00

Recipient must plan to attend at least a 4-year or more college or university degree program, full-time. No specific field of study is required. A "B" average or better during high school is required to qualify for the scholarship. The Scholarship Committee of the Lebanon Educational Foundation will make the final selection.

Edward Jones Scholarship \$500.00

The recipient must be a recent graduate of Lebanon High School and plan to attend a four-year college or university after graduation. The recipient must have a minimum weighted GPA of 3.5 or higher. The applicant can plan to study any major or field of study. Financial need will be used in the final selection process. The Scholarship Committee of the Lebanon Educational Foundation will make the final selection.

FFA Alumni Scholarship \$500.00

The recipient must be a LHS senior student who has been an active participant in FFA for a minimum of three years. The recipient must have a 3.0 or higher GPA. The student must complete the FFA Student Involvement form which can be obtained by the FFA President or teacher advisor. The FFA Student Involvement form must be attached to the LEF Scholarship Application. No specific area of study is required. The scholarship is not limited by financial need. The Scholarship Committee of the Lebanon Educational Foundation will make the final selection.

Gibraltar Design Scholarship for Outstanding Student Citizenship and Service \$500.00

The recipient must be a LHS senior student who has been accepted into a trades, vocational, two year or four year college or university. No specific field of study is required to receive this scholarship. The recipient must be a student citizen in good standing and has participated in volunteer service in the Lebanon community. The scholarship is not limited by financial need. The Scholarship Committee of the Lebanon Educational Foundation will make the final selection.

James Rosenstihl Memorial Basketball Scholarship \$500.00 (2)

The recipient must be a LHS senior who is a team member on the LHS boys or girls basketball team and who has been accepted into a public or private, in-state or out-of-state college or university. No specific area of study is required. The scholarship is not limited by financial need. The LHS Varsity Boys and Varsity Girls Basketball coaches will make the selection.

Lucas E. Keesee Memorial Scholarship \$500.00

The recipient must be a LHS graduating senior who has been accepted into an accredited two or four year college or university or a two or four year technical school. The recipient must have a GPA of 2.0 or higher. The student must participate in a sport offered by LHS during their senior year. The student must participate in an organization offered by LHS during their senior year. No specific area of study is required. The scholarship is not limited by financial need. The Scholarship Committee of the Lebanon Educational Foundation will make the final selection.

LEF Scholarship \$500.00

The recipient must be a LHS graduating senior who has been accepted into an accredited two or four year college or university or a two or four year technical school. No specific area of study is required. The Scholarship Committee of the Lebanon Educational Foundation will make the final selection.

LEF Athletic Scholarship \$300.00

The recipient must be a LHS graduating senior who has been accepted into an accredited two or four year college or university or a two or four year technical school. Must have participated on an athletic team throughout high school and maintained a B average. No specific area of study is required. The Scholarship Committee of the Lebanon Educational Foundation will make the final selection.

Marilyn Suzanne Kern Memorial Scholarship \$500

Recipient has been accepted and will attend Purdue University, achieved a "B" average or better and has participated in extra-curricular activities. No specific area of study is required. The Scholarship Committee of the Lebanon Educational Foundation will make the final selection.

Margaret O'Brien Scholarship \$250.00 (2)

The recipient must be a LHS graduating senior who is a member of the wrestling team or a Tiger Tender and has been accepted into an accredited two or four year college or university or a two or four year technical school. No specific area of study is required. The Scholarship Committee of the Lebanon Educational Foundation will make the final selection.

Denise McLaughlin Memorial Scholarship \$500.00

The recipient must be a LHS senior student who has been accepted into a trade, vocational, two year or four year college or university public or private. A minimum of a GPA 3.0 is required. No specific area of study is required. The applicant must complete an essay about Community Service, what you have done to make your community a better place to live. The Scholarship Committee of the Lebanon Educational Foundation will make the final selection.

Ralph Wortman Scholarship \$250.00

The recipient must be a LHS senior student who has been accepted into a trade, vocational, two year or four year college or university public or private. The recipient needs to be a past member of the Lebanon Area Boys and Girls Club and provide documentation with the application that they have volunteered at the Lebanon Area Boys and Girls Club. An essay on the impact the club has had on the student is also required.

John Isenhower Memorial Scholarship \$500.00 (2)

Recipient must be a graduating senior and must have played a minimum of one LHS sport for at least two years during high school. The recipient may attend a university or technical school after graduation. The recipient should possess strong leadership skills and a positive mental attitude. A male and female will be awarded the scholarship. The Scholarship Committee of the Lebanon Educational Foundation will make the final selection.

Josh Birge Memorial Scholarship \$1,000.00

Recipient must be an LHS senior graduate who will attend a technical or trade school or a 2-year college or university technical program. A minimum of a "C" average or better is required. Financial need will be a determinate in the final selection process. The Scholarship Committee of the Lebanon Educational Foundation will make the final selection.

K.C. Kays Memorial Scholarship \$1,000.00

Recipient must attend either a university or technical school to study aviation. The Lebanon Educational Foundation's standard scholarship application must be completed and the applicant must complete a 1,000 word essay on the subject: "The Sacrifices Necessary to Keep America Free." The Scholarship Committee of the Lebanon Educational Foundation will make the final selection.

Kiwanis Club of Lebanon Technical Scholarship \$500.00

This scholarship is awarded to an LHS senior graduate who will be attending a technical or trade program or school after graduation. The recipient must exemplify good citizenship and service to the community and/or school. The Scholarship Committee of the Lebanon Educational Foundation will make the final selection.

Kiwanis Club of Lebanon Scholarship \$750.00 (2)

This scholarship is awarded to an LHS senior graduate who will be attending a 2-year or 4-year college or university. The recipient must exemplify good citizenship and service to the community and/or school. The Scholarship Committee of the Lebanon Educational Foundation will make the final selection.

NorthPark Community Credit Union \$1000.00

The recipient must be an LHS senior student who has been accepted into a trade, vocational, two year or four year college or university (public or private, in-state or out-of-state). The recipient must have a 3.0 GPA or higher. The applicant must plan to study Business, Finance or Accounting. The scholarship is not limited to financial need. The Scholarship Committee of the Lebanon Educational Foundation will make the final selection.

Obremskey Family Scholarship \$5,000.00

Recipient has been accepted and will attend Indiana University (any campus), excels in leadership and extracurricular activities and is in the top 20% of the graduating class. The Scholarship Committee of the Lebanon Educational Foundation will make the final selection.

Richard and Donna Linton Memorial Scholarship \$1,000.00

Recipient must plan to attend a 4-year Indiana college or university and must be studying business. A "B" average or better is required. The recipient must have a strong desire to become a business owner or an entrepreneur in the future. The Scholarship Committee of the Lebanon Educational Foundation will make the final selection.

Sam Herr Memorial Agricultural Scholarship \$500.00

Recipient must be an LHS senior student who has been accepted into a college or university, public or private, in-state or out-of-state and must plan to study agriculture. The recipient must be in good academic standing and must have maintained a minimum of a "C" average during high school. The applicant's financial need will be taken into consideration. The Scholarship Committee of the Lebanon Educational Foundation will make the final selection.

Witham Family YMCA Vocational Scholarship \$500.00

This scholarship is awarded to an LHS senior graduate who will be attending a 2-year or 4-year college or university public or private, in-state or out of state. The recipient must have a 3.0 GPA or higher. The scholarship is limited by financial need. The student must enroll in a program involving an interdisciplinary for not-for-profits.

Witham Family YMCA Volunteer Scholarship \$1,000.00

This scholarship is awarded to an LHS senior graduate who will be attending a 2-year or 4-year college or university public or private, in-state or out of state. The recipient must have a 3.0 GPA or higher. The recipient must provide documentation showing volunteerism in the community, particularly at the Witham Family YMCA (no less than 30 hours at the YMCA over the course of the student's Junior and senior years).
