The Transition Committee organizational meeting was convened at 7 p.m. at the Zionsville Town Hall on January 20, 2009. Eagle Township Trustee Judith Essex welcomed the committee and introductions were made. Gene Thompson gave an overview of the previous work of the Plan Committee. The committee elected Matt Price as President and Jeff Papa as Secretary.

The Committee then moved to the creation of subcommittees. The committees were composed with the following initial charges:

Governance

- 1. Redistricting Matters;
- 2. Expansion and changes to boards and commissions (parks, zoning appeals, plan commission);
- 3. Legislative steps needed; and
- 4. Update of poor relief guidelines.

Budget/Finance

1. Formulate 2010 budget recommendation by April/May to meet deadlines

Public Safety

- 1. Two tiered service issues;
- 2. Primary provision of police through Sheriff in the rural district; and
- 3. fire issues.

Land Use/Zoning

1. Codify/adopt ordinances for new Zionsville in accordance with the plan

Parks

- 1. Merger of township parks into town parks; and
- 2. cemetery issues.

Infrastructure

- 1. Infrastructure capital improvement recommendations; and
- 2. interlocal with county for rural service area.

These subcommittees are to be composed of members from each of the existing governmental bodies. These members will be the voting members of the subcommittees, but may reach out to other members of the community and other experts for additional input or committee service. Committees may be composed as best suits their particular assignments, but only members of the full Transition Committee will be voting members of subcommittees. (note: the proceedings and minutes of the original plan committee are still available on the bccn reorganization website).

Governance

The Transition Committee discussed the sharing of expenses among the existing governmental bodies. Suggestions were made to set \$30,000 as a budget figure and split this evenly among the bodies. A second suggestion was made to share the \$30,000 by relative size of budgets. This item was tabled until after the
